**SUB: SAS Part I Examination scheduled to be held from
24th to 28th June ,2019 – issue of Roll numbers.**

The names of the candidates of this organization who have been permitted to appear in the SAS Part I Examination to be held from 24th to 28th Jun-2019(no examination on 26/06/2019), the Roll Nos. assigned to them and the stations at which they are to appear for the exam are enclosed as Annexure 'A' & 'B'.

2) SAS Part-I Examination will be held on the dates as per programme intimated by HQrs.office at IN Sailors Institute 'Sagar',30, Wode House Road, Mumbai in respect of candidates who have opted for Mumbai centre and at Area Accounts office(Navy), V.T.Cross Road, Perumanoor P.O. , Kochi-682015

3) Due to administrative reasons and moderate number of 556 candidates it has been decided by the Competent Authority to conduct the Examination at 18 centres only. PCsDA/CsDA are requested to provide accommodation for outstation candidates if available, on request. **The change of centres on any ground shall not be accepted.**

4) As per SAS Rule 14(b), each permission to appear in SAS Part I or Part II examination will count as one chance against the respective part, whether he/she actually sits for the examination or not unless he/she is specifically allowed to withdraw his/her name by the CGDA. In accordance with the ibid proviso read with SAS Rule 14(d) withdrawal of the candidate not submitted within laid down time period would count as a chance. It may further be clarified that under no circumstances request for withdrawal in respect of candidates availing special chance will be accepted. **As such failure to appear in this examination by way of absenteeism or medical ground and request submitted after time limit specified in SAS Rules will entail forfeiture of one of the four valuable chances allowed to candidates as per revised SAS Rules.** The candidates may be informed accordingly. The detail guidelines are also available in CGDA's Website.

5) Further, it is clarified that this is the last SAS Part-I examination in old syllabus and benefits, if any, of previous SAS Part-I examination will not be kept alive after this examination. As such, failure to appear to this examination by way of absenteeism or medical ground or withdrawal on personal ground will not be accepted in any circumstances in light of this HQrs office circular dated 26/03/2019 cited on the reference. This may be brought to the notice of all candidates.
